3. A victim in a criminal trial or a member of the victim's immediate family

## MEDIA PERSONNEL AND EQUIPMENT

These requirements apply unless the presiding judge orders otherwise.

1. No more than one television camera
2. No more than one stills photographer
3. No more than one microphone operator and no obtrusive microphones or wiring
4. No operator entry or exit or other distraction when the court is in session
5. No moving equipment when the court is in session
6. No distracting sounds or lights
7. No disruption of proceedings
8. No public expense, to install, operate, or remove modifications to existing sound and lighting systems
9. No media organisation insignia or marking on recording
